INTERNATIONAL WORKERS' DAY

May Day is an annual celebration of workers' struggle against capitalism. Its origins lie in the general strike for an eight-hour working day put down by police gunfire in Chicago in 1886. Its history teaches us the power of the working class to transform society, and the need to overturn the capitalist state.

Our links with the organised working class, the agent of socialist change, are fundamental to our work. Each year, the Socialist asks groups of workers and trade unionists for financial contributions to help maintain the revolutionary workers' press. This year we have again broken our records, printing over 120 greetings, and raising over £8,000.

Fight for jobs, pay and services

- National action is needed to defeat the cuts and privatisation; don't leave branches to fight alone
- A real end to pay restraint and low pay in the public sector - build the fight for public sector-wide action
- Build a campaign within the health sector to reopen the NHS pay talks and fight for a genuine fully funded deal
- Labour councils: stand up against the cuts now and set no-cuts, needs budgets using reserves and borrowing powers
- An incoming Labour government to return the billions stolen from councils by government since 2010
- For nationally coordinated action to defeat the 'alternative care providers', 'wholly owned subsidiaries' and 'STP' cuts and privatisation plans
- For an end to privatisation of public services, and to bring all those privatised back in-house, including the energy companies and probation service
- A Labour government must cancel all 'PFI' private contracts, write off the debts, and bring the services back in-house - no compensation for the big corporations
- Renationalisation of the NHS
- A Labour government must scrap all privately run 'academies' and bring all schools back under the democratic control of councils, with governing bodies to be democratically elected
- Support abortion rights for the women of Northern Ireland

For genuine workers' political representation

- Not a penny of members' money to those MPs and councillors attacking Jeremy Corbyn
- Demand all MPs are accountable - for the mandatory reselection of all Labour MPs, with the right of the unions to nominate onto parliamentary shortlists
- For a new 'Clause IV' with a commitment to a democratic, socialist society, based on the common ownership of the means of production, distribution and exchange
- Restore policy-making power to Labour Party conference - abolish the 'national policy forum'
- Reinstate socialists who have been unfairly expelled or excluded, and ensure their right to be organised
- Allow the affiliation of socialist parties and anti-austerity, anti-racist, socialist-feminist and green campaigns and organisations, in a version of the early federal structure of the Labour Party

Union democracy

- For a general secretary on a worker's wage - no to the £134,000 a year currently paid
- Put the union's money where the fight is - more resources to the branches, not at the centre
- For the right of the union's national conference to debate any issue or rule change it chooses, including the political funds
- Defend branches' rulebook right to campaign to change, modify or replace union policy, including opposing pay claims, free from interference by unelected union officials
- For the election of full-time union officials on a worker's wage - an end to unelected full-time officials calling the shots

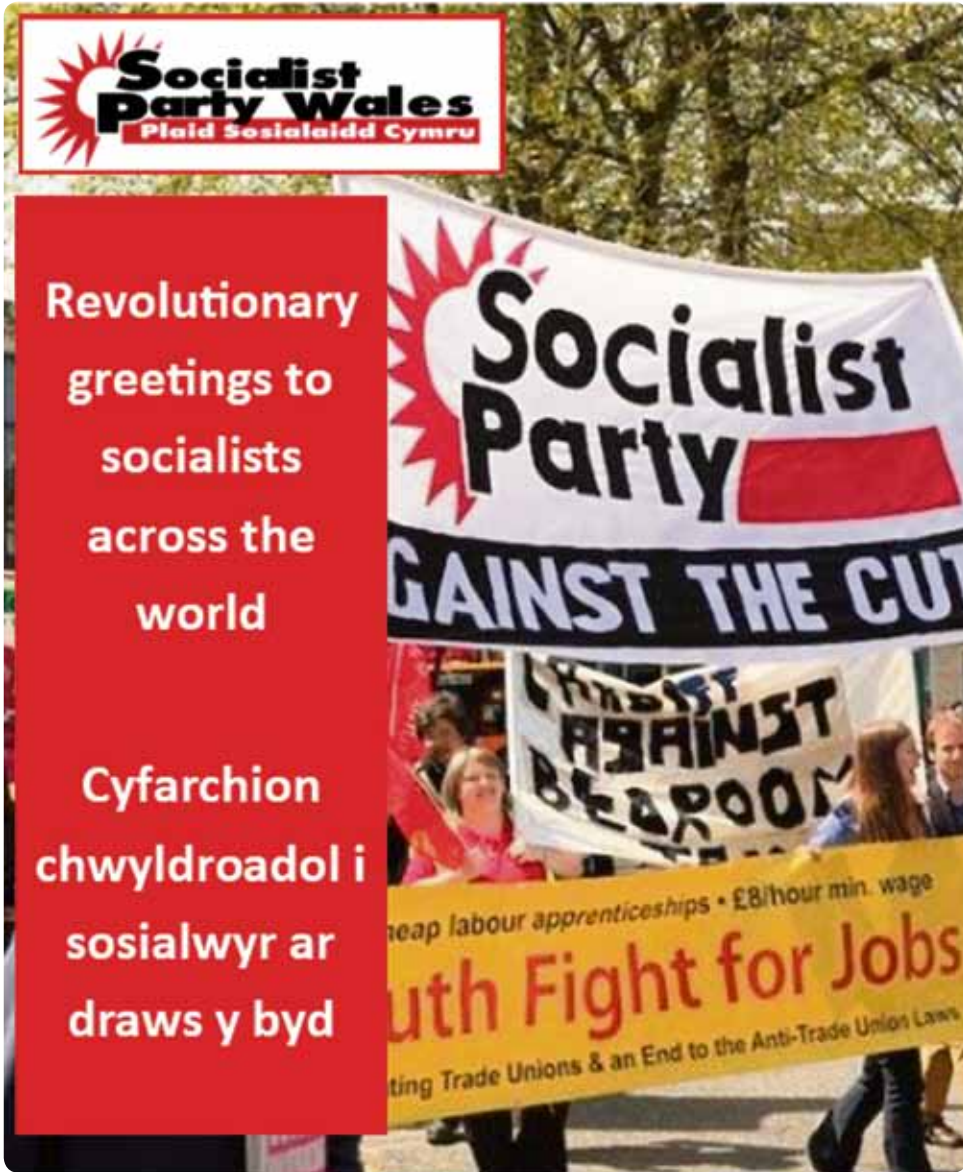

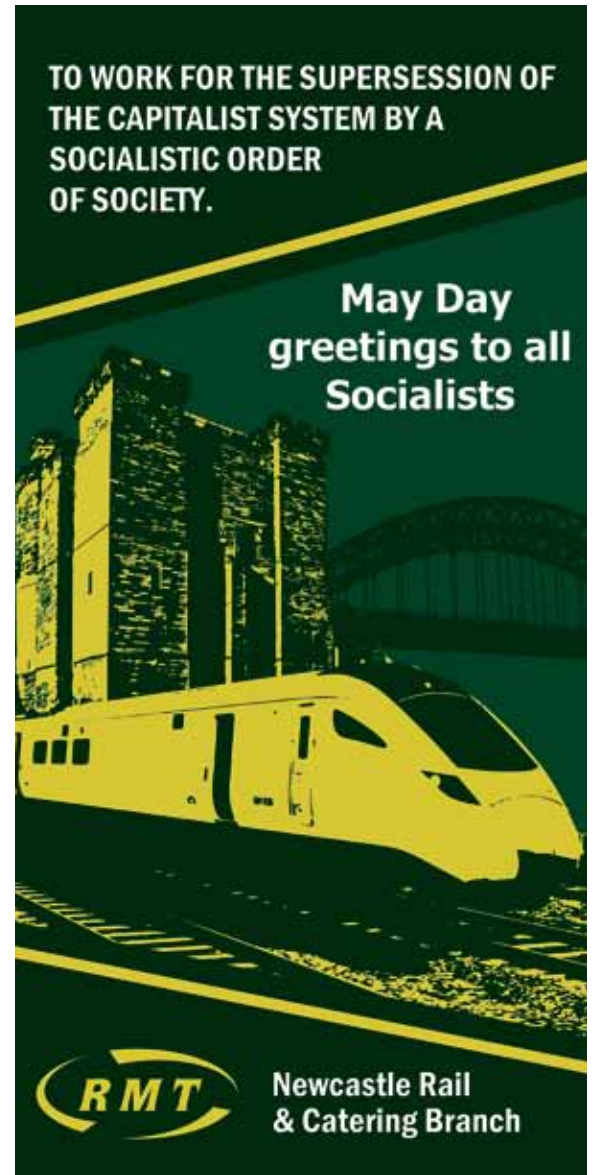

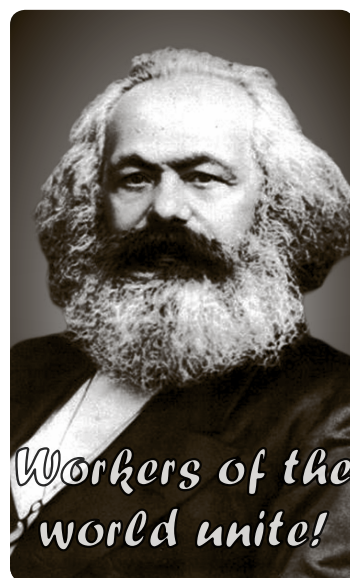
