- BBES say that your pay would stay the same but even if that happened, what • happens after this particular job finishes? You'd have to start on the new BESNA rateand terms & conditions. If nothing was changing, why aren't they sticking with the JIB agreement?
- Your hourly rate will be cut from £16.07 to £10.50 for trunking conduit work.

- If you do not sign the new contract you will be fired with very little chance of redress at an employment tribunal. BBES are holding a gun to your head. This cannot be accepted - it's immoral. No other industry would allow this to go on, why is it happening in construction. BBES and the other rogue employers see construction workers as two a penny and easily replaceable.
- You could be made to work 38 hours of seven days possibly including Saturday and Sunday without being paid any overtime.
- Your right to union representation would go.
- installer grade will be brought in to do skilled work.
- You would lose the right of unfair dismissal on a JIB panel from day one of employment.
- Travel time and fares will go. ٠

- Because your pay rate depends on the job the employer gives you, your rate could change at regular intervals.
- You may find you have to work for £10.50 as that's the only work going on a large site.
