Protest at MPs' sleaze

THE WAY to really shake up the rotten establishment on June 4th is to vote for **No2EU-Yes to Democracy**, Britain's newest political grouping.

Our candidates include postal workers resisting Royal Mail privatisation; Lindsey oil refinery construction workers who went on strike for their jobs in February; health workers, teachers, fire-fighters and other workers in our public services; and the RMT transport workers' union leader **Bob Crow**. The choice between them and the establishment politicians couldn't be clearer.

Our candidates will make no financial gain from being elected. But we don't just say that, we've done it. Amongst our candidates, for example, is the former Labour MP **Dave Nellist**. As an MP from 1983 to 1992, Dave was well known for taking only the average worker's wage and for donating the rest to campaigns and charity.

"Someone claiming benefit who 'worked the system' like MPs do would be interviewed under caution and most likely prosecuted", says Dave. "The difference is, of course, that MPs make the law - and it really is, one law for the rich and one for the poor".

If we don't vote on June 4th one thing is sure: nothing will change. But this time we have a chance to punish the political elite!

That's why workers, pensioners and young people need a new party to fight for our interests. **No2EU-Yes to Democracy** is a coalition set up for the European elections but the forces it has brought together need to continue campaigning after June 4th.
