The 'Strong and Stable' Tory government is hanging by a thread! The incredible response to Jeremy Corbyn's general election campaign showed once and for all that workers and their families are furious after seven years of Tory austerity and a lost decade where our incomes have been cut by a fifth.

But while the Tories may be wounded, weak and more divided, they're not out yet. How can we get rid of them? We have to mobilise the workers and the young people who were inspired to vote for Corbyn's anti-austerity Labour manifesto.



The NSSN calls on the TUC and the unions to organise an emergency national demonstration against the Tories and to demand that Corbyn be given the chance to put his antiausterity programme – including stopping the NHS and schools cuts, abolishing tuition fees, breaking the 1% public sector pay cap and repealing the Trade Union Act – to Parliament. They should also plan co-ordinated strike action to break the 1% public sector pay cap.

There will be hundreds of trade union and anti-cuts campaigners at our annual conference on Saturday 1 July. As usual, we will be giving a platform to workers' struggles, both here and internationally, to build support and solidarity. But this year, it will also be a 'council of war' to discuss how we organise to take on the Tories.

The NSSN was initiated by the RMT and their former general secretary the late Bob Crow in 2006. Nine national unions officially support our campaigning work, as well as many union branches, shop stewards committees and trades councils.
