NSSN TUC Congress rally FIGHT TOGETHER TO GET THE TORIES OUT!

n the year of the 150th anniversary of the Trade Union Congress, the National Shop Stewards Network (NSSN) is again organising a rally before the start of TUC congress.

Delegates will be meeting as the Tory Government lurches from crisis to crisis. The Tories are divided - but they can still stagger on, because the establishment fears how a Corbyn government could raise workers' expectations.

But the trade union movement has to be to the fore in building the mass action that can force them out. Already this year, we have seen strikes by university lecturers force back

the employers, and a whole number of militant disputes that show workers are prepared to fight.
