The Tories tell us to 'work longer hours', 'get a better-paid job', 'wear warmer clothes', 'turn the heating down', 'buy cheaper brands'...

How many ex-bankers are in this government? Not to mention that Tory Chancellor Rishi Sunak has gained entry to the Times Rich List with over £750 million in wealth! What about the crony contracts handed out during the pandemic. They can certainly help themselves.

But the Tories stood by while P&O bosses broke the law and brutally sacked their workforce to drive wages down to starvation levels. The Tories have no answers when it comes to our problems.

Many workers already work long hours, holding down two or three jobs to put food on the table, pay bills and rent.

But why should we work longer hours for poverty pay? Big business bosses are cashing in bumper profits, including energy companies and supermarkets – the same ones responsible for our rocketing energy and food bills!

1.5 million households will struggle to pay for energy and food in 2022. That's a polite way of saying 1.5 million households will be cold and go hungry. Millions more will see their living standards get worse.

We will happily take an extra bank holiday!

How come they can find hundreds of millions for jubilee events, grants for street parties, etc, while more services are closed or privatised, while kids go hungry, public transport fares rise and the NHS suffers ever more?

The Tories want to blame working-class people who are struggling to get by. But we are struggling because the capitalism is a rigged system based on workers being exploited by big business bosses and based on prioritising profit.

WE DON'T HAVE A VOICE - BUILD A NEW MASS WORKERS' PARTY

Starmer's Labour offers no alternative to the Tories as far as working-class people are concerned. Its pledge to 'balance the books' will mean more cuts and austerity, and no relief for those struggling to pay the bills and put food on the table. And locally Labour councillors choose to implement the cuts demanded by the Tory government rather than choosing to stand up for working-class people.

So we need to build a new mass workers' party that stands up for us. The Socialist Party is part of the Trade Unionist and Socialist Coalition (TUSC), set up to enable trade unionists, community campaigners and socialists to stand together against the pro-austerity establishment parties. It is a beginning - a step towards the kind of party we need to deliver a socialist alternative to austerity.

SOCIALISTS ARE ORGANISING AND FIGHTING FOR CHANGE JOIN THE SOCIALIST PARTY!

Everyone should have a warm home, a well-paid job, free education and health, while protecting our environment. The capitalist system makes it clear that isn't on offer! We need to change the system along socialist lines to one that works for us!

That's why we campaign for the building of powerful workers' organisations - militant trade unions and a new mass workers' party.

We need a socialist transformation of society. Instead of handouts to the bosses, we fight for the major firms and banks that dominate the economy to be brought into democratic public ownership. That would give us the basis for socialist change - where the economy is planned sustainably to meet the needs of all and the environment, and run democratically.

MARCH WITH SOCIALISTS ON THE TUC DEMO, 18 JUNE LET'S LINK THE ACTION AND BUILD THE FIGHT BACK

More and more workers across the country are taking on their bosses and voting to strike for a pay rise – bin workers, on the trains, in Royal Mail, bar workers and more.

The Trades Union Congress (TUC), which brings together the six-million strong trade unions in England and Wales, is organising a national demonstration in London on 18 June to say: 'Enough is enough'.

If it is properly built for, if the TUC makes sure that every workplace receives leaflets and subsidised transport is organised, the June demo could be a huge show of strength in numbers.

But to really build on the potential strength of workers, the TUC should use the demonstration as a step towards coordinating strikes for a pay rise.

That is what the Socialist Party will be putting forward on the day - coordinated trade union action, and the building of a mass working-class political force that fights for a socialist alternative.
